 in consideration of the natural love and affection

which I have and bear towards my daughter Mrs Liris James wife of William
 James of Spartanburg District and State aforesaid and also in con-
 sideration of the sum of Five Dollars to me in hand paid have given granted
 bargain and sold and by these presents do give, grant bargain and convey
 to Aldridge Green and Levin Green The following negroes, a negro woman
 named Liddy aged about Twenty five years and her child John about
 one year old also to the said Aldridge and Levin Green ~~the~~ during
 their life and at their death to such other Trustees as I may appoint by
 the Court of Equity In Trust for the following uses and purposes that is to
 say that the said Aldridge Green and Levin Green Trustees as aforesaid shall
 Allow the aforesaid property to visit the negroes above specified to pass to and remain
 in the possession of my said daughter and her present or future husband and
 the profits thereof to be applied to the support of my said daughter and her chil-
 dren but in no manner to be liable for any contract debt or engagement of my
 said daughter or her present or future husband and in case her said husband
 present or future should separate from said Liris James the said property shall not
 be liable to his possession and upon the death of my said daughter the property afo-
 said shall become absolutely the property of her children share and share alike and
 to the end the more effectually to secure the aforesaid object it is hereby declared to be the
 intent of these presents to vest the legal Estate in the aforesaid property in the said
 Aldridge & Levin Green Trustees as aforesaid with a general supervision over the
 same and upon a case occurring presenting to a Court of competent Jurisdiction
 sufficient evidence of said intention on the part of any husband of my said daughter
 to transfer remove out of the State or otherwise dispose of the said property or
 any part thereof the said Trustees are hereby authorized upon the order of any Judge
 of the Court of Equity at Chambers or in open Court to seize and take into their
 possession subject nevertheless to the final order of such Court in due proceedings
 had for that purpose
