of a Writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas and Sessions held  
for the District of Greenville the sixteenth day of April in the year of our  
Lord One Thousand eight Hundred and Forty seven at the south of the State for  
costs to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements  
of Pinckney Springfield to levy the sum of Twenty Eight Dollars 87 1/2 cents  
I have seized and taken of the lands and Tenements of the said Pinckney Springfield  
One Hundred (more or less) acres situated and being in the District of Greenville  
a adjoining lands of Tho Springfield and others being the same Tract whereon def-  
-endants Pinckney Springfield, now lives,

And Whereas the said premises with their appurtenances  
since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said Writ of Fieri Facias before  
mentioned have exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by Chancy Store  
of the District of Greenville for the sum of One Hundred Dollars being the highest  
sum that was bid and thereof Now know ye that I O'Hecke Sheriff afo-  
-said by virtue of the said Writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as  
aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such cases made and provided and for and  
in consideration of the said sum of One Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid or secured  
to be paid by the said Chancy Store the receipts and payment whereof I do truly ack-  
-nowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain  
and sell unto the said Chancy Store his heirs and assigns forever the said tract  
piece and parcel of Land with its appurtenances and all the Estate right title and  
interest which the said Pinckney Springfield of right had of in and to the same

To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of Land with  
its appurtenances unto the said Chancy Store his heirs and assigns forever as fully  
and absolutely as I the said O'Hecke might lawfully or ought to grant bargain  
and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Fieri Facias  
or otherwise
