Trickery 3x Thence S 75 E 15 Chs to a sycamore 3x Thence S 18 W 8.25 Chs to a Chestnut  
pole Thence S 10 E 8.93 Chs to a sycamore 3x Thence N 78 W 9 Chs to a sycamore 3x  
Thence N 53 W 3.65 to a P. C. 3x gone Thence N 79 W 9.25 to a Stone Thence N 45  
E 3.60 to a Chestnut 3x Then on Samuel Howard line S 65 W 4.50 Chs to a P. C. stump  
Thence N 21 W 14 Chs to a Stake near a rd rock Thence N 18 E 6.60 Chs to a Stone

of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and forty nine  
and in the Seventy Fourth of the Independence of the United States of America
