Beginning on a Stake 37 on the North head of Hanging Creek Thence S 45° 40' E 8.00 ch to a Chestnut 37 Thence S 23° E 5.85 to a Pine 37 Thence S 18° 45' E 4.75 ch to a Black Oak 37 Thence S 83° E 8.40 to a Maple 37 Thence North 1.10 ch to a Black Gum Thence N 10° E 9.10 ch to a Dog Wood Thence to the beginning containing by estimation Fifteen Acres but the same more or less To go with the all and singular the rights more by these presents and appurtenances belonging to the same as in any
