the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid on the credit of twelve months
whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said Land for sale on the first Monday
in October on the present year And Whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the same
day expose to sale at publick outcry the said Land at the credit aforesaid when Willis
Benson was the last and highest bidder to whom the Land was struck off for

road adjoining lands of Silas Holloway and D. D. Garrison and others containing
Two hundred and Sixty nine acres more or less being part of two original grants
made to Francis Prentiss and James Blaxingame and hath bounds works &
