Roberts of Greenville District, the following property to wit: Two negroes Ann Elliot and Edwin together with their future increase to have and to hold the said property unto the said John W. Roberts his Executors and Administrators forever in Trust for the sole and separate use of the said Sarah Hewitt for and during her natural life and thereafter and immediately after her death to the use of her issue if a deceased child of any to take the parents share. The said property to be in no wise subject to the debts or contracts of the said Sarah Hewitt in the event of her husband Geo. C. Hewitt's death. In Witness whereof I the said Martha Astmore have hereunto set my hand and seal this 13th day of September one thousand eight hundred and Forty Seven and in the Seventh Year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America
