from thence to the time present shall be utterly null and void anything herein contained Assign
to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding And it is covenanted and agreed
upon by and between the parties to these presents that until default shall be made in
payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth and the interest on the same it shall be
and may be lawful to and for the said C.S. Evans peaceably and quietly to hold
use and occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and
relieved and every part thereof with its appurtenances and to have receive and take the
rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoof any thing herein
contained to the contrary notwithstanding
