Clarke of the District and State of said. He has granted bargain sold and conveyed
and by this presents do Grant bargain sell and convey unto the said A. D. Clarke and his
Heirs and assigns forever the right and privilege of stopping and making a dam for the
purpose of fulfilling machinery across said Shoal or water fall and to attach said dam
in proper manner and form to my said Land lying at said Shoal or water fall which said
privilege and right I have myself my Heirs Executors Administrators and assigns
do hereby warrant and defend unto the said A. D. Clarke his Executors Administrators
