of the sum of Two Thousand and Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by James A Moon of the same place have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant his said land and release unto the said James A Moon all that piece or parcel of Land containing Two Thousand and Sixty Eight Acres more or less being a part of the tract originally owned and possessed by George Wright deceased and lying in the State and District aforesaid on Reedy Fork waters of Reedy River and wherein James A. A. Moon now lies and according to a late survey hath boundaries and marks better as boundaries as aforesaid boundaries annexed will plainly show.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaries and appurtenances belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining

To thare and the thole all and singular the said premises unto the said James A Moon except a grave yard twelve feet wide and thirty feet long his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James A Moon his heirs executors and Administrators against myself and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
