 we have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and
 sell to Thomas J. Cantor One Hundred and fifty six Acres of Land more or less being
 said District on a piece of the old farm being part of a Tract of Land granted to
 John de la Torre by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the third day of June 1787
 Also a part of a Tract of Land granted to Robert Galt on an assign of the Survey
 of Thomas Pinckney on the twentieth day of April 1788 The said two tracts being adjacent
 to his late wife to the said Thomas J. Cantor as follows Beginning on a piece of land
 known as Land now William H. Cantor A 55 79 chains to Hickory St Thence N 33 E 15
 chains to a post called X Thence A 55 79 55 E to a Stake in a corner of the same
 called da Cantor Thence N 33 E 15 55 chains to a post in same line Thence S 62 E 33 to
 a post called X Thence S 62 E 33 to a post called X Thence S 62 E 33 to
 a corner of the same land and thence to the beginning corner including an hundred and fifty six Acres more
 or less together with all and singular the rights, liberties, appurtenances to the same
 belonging or in any wise incident, To have and to hold to the said Thomas J. Cantor
 his heirs and assigns forever and to his heirs and assigns forever and to his heirs and assigns forever
 and estate forever here by warrant and power herein before expressed to the said
 Thomas J. Cantor his heirs and assigns forever from ourselves our heirs and assigns and
