Cutler on the 29th day of March in the year of our Lord 1797 and agreeable to the lines of the said Tract of Land as directed by the said Harrison Gibson and Charles Cutler then being a certain line extended in a straight course from line to line of the sd Land the sd line running from a certain Stake Line standing in the Lane Thence to a P. M. and with the direction of the said concludental line to the end line of Lane corner S. W. end of sd Land agreeable to the old line.</p>
