W. Jones have given and do hereby give to my said children the following property  
 respectively. To my son W B Thompson I have already given property in the value  
 of Fifteen Thousand five hundred and fifty dollars to which I now add the follow  
 ing negroes. Harry's Service this wife Eliza and the five youngest children amounting  
 in all to Eighteen Thousand and fifty dollars I now give to my daughter Elizabeth  
 Jones in Trust as here after set forth the following property which I estimate  
 of equal value with that given to the brother The tract of Land on Hobkane co  
 in which I have given to me a Case of Conveyance and now the following negroes Charles  
 (Reference to Charles Elandie Waspens)  
 Joseph M<sup>o</sup>ch Jones Sam<sup>l</sup> Monday's Keller and their eleven children Keller James  
 the three children (one Selby) child the above named negroes I give in Trust  
 to John M Jones in the only proper use and benefit and behoof of my said daug  
 hter Elizabeth W Jones such use as she may have being at her death Sub  
 ject to the subject to the sale or disposal of by the said John M Jones a  
 subject to his contracts and engagements as I am now in debt but anticipate the  
 receipt of money enough to pay these debts yet as it is possible I may not receive it  
 amount as a consideration to the above gift to my children that if I require it my  
 daughter shall pay \$3000. in the amount given the said my son the same amount  
 this land the whole of the property to remain in my possession until the end of the next  
 year
