The State of South Carolina

I, Thomas Goldsmith of the County of Greenville District in said State do hereby certify that in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me paid by my son William Goldsmith have given & conveyed and by these presents do give & convey unto the said William Goldsmith as James S. Ferrall the following Slaves to wit Permelia about 15 years old, Amanda about 25 years old and two Children Margaret 3 years old and Permelia 6 months old with their increase. I will must nevertheless the said Slaves and their increase are to be kept and employed for the sole use and benefit of my said daughter Permelia Ferrall and her family free from any charge for the debts of her husband during her natural life and at her death to be equally divided among the children and if my daughter Permelia Ferrall should die leaving neither child or children or their descendants shall live until they are of age or marry then and in that case the said Slaves and their increase are to belong to the above Abner S. Ferrall and I do warrant the said Slaves in the said Wm Goldsmith or Samuel S. Ferrall as Trustees as aforesaid.
