South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that we Polly Kelly and Isaac Kelly of Anderson District and Greenville State have for and in Consideration

of the sum of Twenty Five Dollars to us in hand paid by Elijah Estlin bargain and released and to those presents do grant bargain sell transfer and release unto Elijah Estlin his heirs and assigns all the right title interest and advantage which we have or have to a certain Tract of Land lying in Greenville District in Darby Creek in the County of Rutherford containing One Hundred and Fifty Acres more or less being the Tract of Land of which the late George Smith did seize and possess and which passed to certain of his heirs by his last will and testament

to have and to hold all and singular the said interest unto said Elijah Estlin his heirs and assigns forever and we hereby bind ourselves and heirs to warrant and defend all and singular the said interest unto the said Elijah Estlin his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every person claiming the same or any part thereof

South Carolina } Amos Tollison personally came before me and made oath that he saw Polly Kelly and Isaac Kelly sign and deliver to Elijah Estlin the within deed of Conveyance for the use and purpose therein mentioned and that David Rodgers and Amos Tolson were subscribing with himself seen to and subscribed the 14th day of January 1852 Henry Smith M.C.

The State of South Carolina } Henry Smith one of the magistrates of the District of Greenville do certify unto all whom it may concern that Polly Kelly wife of Isaac Kelly and joint grantor of the within deed this day came before me and upon being severally and separately examined by me did declare that she doth freely voluntarily and without compulsion deed and give of any part of her persons whatsoever release and convey all her interest and rights of whatsoever kind unto Elijah Estlin his heirs and assigns forever and to all and singular the persons therein mentioned and released
