



 at Sheriff Sale which was set as the property of Morris Compton and com-  
 mitted to me by the said E. S. Irvine by Messrs. Taylor Sheriff of Greenville  
 District by their bearing date the first day of October in the year of our Lord  
 One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty

Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments  
 and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident  
 appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
 mentioned unto the said Harman Waldrip his Heirs and Assigns forever And I  
 hereby bind myself and my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant  
 defend and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Harman  
 Waldrip and his Heirs and against all persons whomsoever lawfully claim-  
 ing or to claim the same in any part thereof
