

In the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina on the 26th day of April 1832 between the Plaintiff and Defendant in the Town of Greenville in the District and State of South Carolina and between the Plaintiff and Defendant and the Building thereon bargained and sold as the premises office of the Greenville Mercantile containing fifty feet square and three stories high together with the said building thereon now erected with all and singular parts thereof and fixtures belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To have and to hold said lot of land and the said house together with the appurtenances unto the said D. Dunham his heirs and assigns forever provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said O. H. Wells Ins. their Executors or Administrators shall well and truly return to the said D. Dunham the sum of Nine Hundred and ten dollars and eight cents and interest thereon according to the true intent and meaning and that the said debts etc above mentioned then and from thenceforth shall and may remain fully paid and satisfied anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding and the same to be paid in payment of the aforesaid sum of as before set forth and interest for the same it shall and may be lawful to and for the said O. H. Wells to hold and occupy to hold and enjoy all and singular the premises and intreis above granted and released and every part thereof with the appurtenances and at no time to have recurrance and take the rents yrons and profits thereof to his the said O. H. Wells own particular use and behoof any thing herein contained to the contrary here in any wise notwithstanding.
