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Where all men of this State are District of South Carolina and District of South Carolina as well as the sum of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by J. Edwin Ware of the State and District of South Carolina have given granted bargain sold and released by their presents do give grant bargain sell and release unto the said J. Edwin Ware Executor his certain Executors and Administrators the following named Negro Slaves and the Chattle (viz) 1st a young woman named Fanny with her children Jacob, Isaac, Adam, Rebecca, Louisa, and Laura, Isaac (Wagoner) Ann his wife and her children Robert and Peter (a Blacksmith) Mary his wife and her children Sarah and Alice, Simons, Suffolk wife, Philip and an infant female child and her older children, Elliott, Nick and Fanny, Moses (a young fellow) a Boy named Washington, and a young girl named Emaline. Together with all the furniture and inventory of said Slaves Also my entire Lot of Blacksmith Tools with the appurtenances of the shop. Also the one half of all my plantation Tools, Wagon, Carts, Harness, &c. Also the one half of all my Hens, Mules, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep and Stock of every kind. Also the one half of all my furniture and increase and issue Also the one half of all my furniture and kitchen furniture. Also the one half of all provisions, provision Stays and such other things which may be on hand at the time of my death.

To have and to hold all and singular the foregoing named negro Slaves with their increase, plantation, Stock and its increase with all other such things named and described Chattle unto the said J. Edwin Ware, Executor his certain Executors, and Administrators, for the sole use and separate benefit of my daughter Jane Jones during her natural life and at her death to remain due to my Grand daughter Mary W. Ware in fee simple. And that this former Provision however that I reserve to myself the use and control of said negroes and other named Chattle during my natural life obligating myself thereby for their care and support and to the said State Slaves for the same during such time that which reservation shall
