wants do give, Grant and Release unto the said George S. Green "a certain Tract
plantation of Land lying on both sides of Marmelone Creek and Laram Branch
parts of Laram River being a part of those Tracts now being granted to George H.
all made Salmon River the other part to Henry Weston containing One hundred
Fifty Acres the same more or less.

ever lawfully claiming as to claim the same or any part thereof.
