to me in hand paid by Aldridge Green of the said District and in the State aforesaid I have granted, bargained, sold and release, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Aldridge Green, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the State and District aforesaid, on a branch of Purdy Creek, branch of Two of Enore River, containing one hundred acres, more or less, bounded as follows viz, Beginning on a pine, between the said Andrews and Hemmels, running N. 78 E 2 1/2 chains to the line between said Andrews & Hemmels, thence with said line South to Park oak 3/4 corner between, said Andrews and Hemmels thence N 55 W 19, 70 to a Post oak 3/4 thence N 14 W 15 to a stake oak 3/4 thence North 57 E 9, 50 3/4 P. O thence N 76 E 10, 11 1/2 P. O 3/4 thence N 32 E 7, 50 to Maple 3/4 thence N 38 E 5, 50 to Pine 3/4 on Aldridge Green Land near the head of the said branch thence with Greens line to the beginning pine which is the line to the survey.
