in the state of South Carolina in consideration of one thousand eight hundred Dollars to me paid by Alexander Norton of Greenville County in the state of North Carolina have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander Norton all that lot or parcel of land in the County of Greenville beginning at a stake near the Pinecomb Road at the corner of Peter Guards Lot "New Mrs. Curtis" and runs thence N 30 degrees West near the said Pinecomb Road Two hundred and twenty and a half feet to a stake on the avenue leading to Dandry M<sup>r</sup> Beed residence thence South 17 degrees West Two hundred and nineteen feet and a half to a stake on the side of the said avenue, thence South 30 degrees East one hundred and sixty six and a half feet to a stake Peter Guards New Mrs. Curtis corner thence North 21 degrees East Two hundred and eighty nine feet to the beginning containing by estimation one acre and twenty nine poles (be the same more or less) and sold to the said John C. Williams by W. M. Earle and sold to W. M. Earle by Dandry M<sup>r</sup> Beed Esquire. I convey all the above named land with the exception of a small slip of land lying in front of and between the lot above conveyed and the Pinecomb Road having been heretofore conveyed by W. M. Earle to the Town Council of Greenville for the benefit of the public as a part of said Road together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Alexander Norton his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alexander Norton his heirs and assigns against me my heirs or any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
