I know all men by these Presents I doth make

Thomas Bridges and Ambros W. Bridges their

Sons and Legatees in remainder under the last will and Testament of Edward
 Bridges deceased late of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration
 of One hundred and fifteen to each of us to us paid by Benjamin Bridges and
 William W. Bridges of Greenville District in the State aforesaid sum of one hundred, long-
 drawn, sets and released unto by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said Benjamin Bridges and William W. Bridges all our right title
 interest and estate legal or equitable present or past and to a certain tract
 of Land formerly owned and occupied by the said Edmund Bridges deceased in his
 life time containing two hundred and thirty acres more or less situated in
 the Head waters of Reedy River in said District and bounded by lands of John
 Russell, W. Russell, Bates, Phillips, Moore and Watson, being a chain of four rods
 and divided by the last will and testament of the said Edmund Bridges deceased to
 his daughter Frances Bridges during her life under certain conditions and at her
 death Benjamin, Thomas, Ambros C., Arthur, Mary, Anna, Bridges and Frances
 Vanderson all the interest in said land which we held under said will being equally con-
 sidered and released.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Privileges, Hereditaments
 and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur-
 tenancing. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Benjamin Bridges and William W. Bridges their heirs and assigns for
 ever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Benjamin and
 William W. Bridges their heirs and assigns against us and our Heirs and against
 every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
