Samuel A. Tammes Commissioner as aforesaid and for the better securing the paym
of his money aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of one dollar by him the said Sa
unders, Wm. and A. Tammes Commissioner as aforesaid to the said Barksdale Charles in hand
over him paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sett
in Equity, Release, Convey and Confirm unto the said Samuel A. Tammes and his
successors in office forever all That Tract or parcel of Land lying and being
laid in the State of South Carolina aforesaid known and described by a survey made by John
Haley & Deputy Surveyor Oct 1st 1852 as No. 5 and described by said Haley in a
deed of him then made, thus beginning at Rock 34 on Branch running thence
to Rock 34 S. 24° E. 21¹/₂ E. 16. 35 feet running to Thence N 58° E. 7. 88
of Rock 34 Thence N 33¹/₂ E. 41. 55 W. 55 Walnut 34 Thence S 45¹/₂ E. 47. 40. Thence
