amongst his Children. The Land lying in the State and District aforesaid in
the Branches of Mountain Creek the eighth part or pieces of said Tract being
my wife share and interest in said Tract of Land.

Together with all and singular the rights members the debtors
and apprentices to my share of said property.

To have and to hold all and singular unto the said Walter
Chandler this day and affixes hereon But it is agreed and especially understood
between the parties that of the above named property J S Macken shall pay or
cause to be paid to the said Walter Chandler the sum of One Thousand and Sixty
Nine Dollars & 68 Cents on or before the First day of January next then due
of the Mortgage and every sum contained to be null and void unless to be paid
remain in full force and virtue.
