Whereas by these presents that Elizabeth Rice of the District and State of South Carolina wife of John Cochran have given transfer and delivery to Elizabeth Cochran of Chatham District the following personal property To wit one negro girl named Hannah about 12 years old together with the following inclosed

To have and to hold the said property unto the said Elizabeth Rice as Trustee her executor and Administrator for the said John Cochran and to use for the following uses and purposes that is to say in trust for the sole and separate use of the said Elizabeth Cochran my daughter during her natural life, the life time intred in the same to be in no wise responsible for the debts or contracts nor the present or future debts of the husband and in the event of the said negro becoming an apprentice then the said negro to be paid out for their support and after their Taxes and all necessary expenses are paid therefrom do of any part even by the before mentioned Trustee to the said Elizabeth Cochran annually during her natural life term and thereupon and immediately after her death to the use of her issue, the issue of a deceased child to take the part share with the rest of her children
