This Indenture made the fourth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two between Samuel Thomas Esquire, Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville S. C. in the said State of the one part and Sarah Hecht of the other part

Whereas Sarah S. C. Hecht Administratrix of George S. Hecht deceased on or about the eleventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one exhibited her Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville S. C. in the said State against Sarah Hecht, Martha J. Hecht and others praying amongst other things for the sale of real estate of said deceased therein described and for purposes therein set forth

And the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came to be heard at the June Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did Order Adjudge and decree that said Lands should be sold at Public Auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the Terms and for the purposes mentioned in their Honorable order as by reference made to the Registry of the said Court will appear And the said Samuel A. Thomas Commissioner of the said Court after having duly advertised the said Lands for sale by Public Auction on the fourth of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of Auction sell and dispose of the said Lands hereinafter described unto the said Sarah Hecht for the sum of Six hundred and twenty dollars she being at that price the highest bidder for the same
