


William Fuller Deed The State of South Carolina
 To For
 W Fuller Land

Know all men by these presents that I William Fuller of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred Dollars to me paid by Fleming W Fuller of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Fleming W Fuller all that tract or parcel of Land situate in the State & District aforesaid on Neals creek waters of South Syger River it being a tract of Land sold to W Chick by Austin Almond in the year 1828 and to the said W Fuller by W Chick in the year 1837 and runs as follows beginning on a red oak 3+ in place of Beck 3+ thence N 25 W 65.00 chains to a Sycamore 3+ thence S 77 W 33.40 to a stake or dogwood 3+ thence S 20 E 15.00 chs to a large Poplar in field down thence S 70 W 20 chains to a Spanish oak 3+ thence S 3 W 14.00 chains to a W.O. 3+ thence S 41 E 10.00 chains to a stake on Neals line thence S 88 E 28.50 chs to Hickory stump 3+ thence N 60 E 37.00 chains to a stake 3+ thence S 30 E 21.50 chains to a stake 3+ thence N 65 E 6.50 to the being part of two hundred acres granted to James Neal and the whole of a tract granted to Angus McColister containing 136 Acres also One piece of Land bought by me from Thomas Barton containing five acres and bounded as follows. beginning on a sycamore a corner of the above tract thence N 77 E 4.25 chains to a chestnut 3+ thence S 25 E 12.00 chains to W.O. 3+ thence S 30 W 5.00 to a chest 3+ N 25 W to the beginning making in all two two hundred and forty two Acres more or less bounded by Lands of by James McKinny W W Hawkins Millington Barton W W Robertson & of W Fuller. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W Fuller his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W Fuller his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this thirty first day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six and in the eighty first year of the Independence of the United States of America Signed sealed and Delivered in the presence of M C Goodlett Cross ^{his} Garnett _{mark} W Fuller

Know all men by these presents that I Hamilton Watson of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of One hundred and sixty Dollars to me paid by Waddy Thompson of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Waddy Thompson all that piece parcel and tract of Land containing twenty five acres more or less situated lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the East end of Part Mountain and having the following metes lines and bounds beginning at a Stone and running thence with W Roberts land N 72 E 38.75 to a Stone cluster thence with Loulands land S 31 E 45.50 to a Stone thence S 33 W 23 to a pine thence N 48 W to a stone thence S 33 W 10 to a Sourwood thence S 48 E 5.50 to a Stone thence S 33 W 2.79 to a pine thence N 48 W 15.26 to the beginning a plot of the same being herunto annexed conveyed to me by John B Gunter by deed of 24th May 1836. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
