 State aforesaid upon the East side of the Augusta Road and
 having the following lines, meters and bounds viz Beginning at
 a Stake 3+ on the Augusta Road and running thence South
 58 East 330 feet to B O W+ thence South 26 West 198 feet to a Stake 3+
 thence South 40 West 40 feet to a Stake 3+ thence N 50 West
 350 feet to a Stake 3+ on said Augusta Road thence with said
 Road N 33 East 204 feet to the beginning. Together with all and
