This indenture mad this third day of Nov-
ember in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty six between Robt

McKay ordinary of the District aforesaid and Jandy J Goodlett of
the same State and District. Whereas a Writ of Summons to divide or
sell a certain tract of Land hereinafter described of the estate of
Eli Alewine of said District deceased issued from the Court of ordinary
of said District and upon the return thereof the Judges of said Court
did determine that the said land could not be divided without injury
to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the
Sheriff of the District aforesaid on a credit of twelve months with
interest from day of sale. Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did ad-
vertise the said land for sale on the first Monday in November
in the year above mentioned, and Whereas the Sheriff aforesaid
did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry on the credit
aforesaid the said Land, when the said Jandy J Goodlett was the last
and highest bidder to whom the said Land was struck off for
the sum of One Hundred and eighty Two Dollars. Now this inden-
ture Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of one hundred
and Eighty Two Dollars to me paid, and secured to be paid, I have
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said Jandy J Goodlett and his
heirs and assigns forever all that Tract of Land situated in said
District on waters of Smiths Upper River bounded by Lands of Elijah
Dill Thomas Chandler Tidcorn Moon J Goodlett Andrew Adam and by a
tract of Land belonging to Estate Eli Alewine and purchased by Eli
Carney containing One hundred and Eighty Two and three fourth acres
reference to a Plot filed in the papers in the ordinarys office will
more fully explain the boundanes. Together with the appurtenances there-
to belonging and all the estate right title interest claim or demand
which the said Eli Alewine deceased at the time of his death had
in or to the same. To have and to hold the said Tract of Land
together with all and singular the premises improvements and appur-
tenances to the said Jandy J Goodlett his heirs and assigns forever

grant and bequeath unto the said Louisa Caroline Smith that
tract of land laid off for her being part of the original survey
of Cha Dean & Moses Langley containing one hundred acres more
or less beginning at a Rock at Rocky Creek thence S 80 W 16.60 to
a Stake Cor. Thence S 13 W 28 1/2 ch to a Stake on S Hamby's land thence
with Hamby's land S 33 E 30 ch to a rock Cor. Thence N 42 E. a new
line dividing it from E Miller's land 57 ch to a poplar Cor at the
Creek thence up said creek 11 ch to the beginning Cor. on inspection
of the plat annexed will more fully appear. Together with
all and singular the rights members & hereditaments and appurtenan-
ces to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or apper-
taining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Louisa Caroline Smith her heirs and
assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my self & my heirs to warrant
and forever defend all the premises before mentioned unto the said
Louisa Caroline Smith her heirs and assigns against the claim
of any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
