 Waddy Thompson shall well and truly pay the note aforesaid and
 save harmless the said I W Brooks from all liability on account
 of said indorsement then this deed by way of mortgage to be null
 and void else to remain in full force & virtue with full power to
 the said I W Brooks to take into his possession the negroes
 aforesaid and sell as many of them as may be necessary to pay the mortgage aforesaid

 Shapleigh W Barton of the same State and District the receipt and pay-
 ment whereof are hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and
 conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey
 unto the said Shapleigh W Barton his heirs and assigns a certain tract
 or parcel of land situated in the said State and District on the left hand
 fork of Middle Tyger river adjoining lands of William Barton I the Center
 and Joseph Barton. Beginning on a white oak thence N 68 63 6 ch to a maple
 thence South 65 67 ch 50 to a chestnut oak thence N 85 6 12 ch 90 to a stone thence
 N 36 11 ch 15 to a pine thence S 61 W 17 50 to a Spanish oak thence N 17 W 22 ch 25 to
 a stone thence N 55 6 10 ch to a white oak S 87 6 17 ch 25 to hickory thence N
 16 ch 70 to a chestnut thence N 57 ch to a hickory on the millstone Stone branch
 thence down said branch 25 ch to Spanish oak thence S 78 W 6 ch 10 to
 pine thence S 16 6 8 ch 60 to a chestnut thence S 55 W 7 ch 95 thence to a white
 oak dead on the mill branch thence S 11 W 7 ch 80 to the mouth of said

branch then South 11 ch 50 to the beginning containing by estimation one hun-
 dred & Sixty three acres be the same more or less being of a tract deeded
 by John Erickson to Jesse Center from Jesse Center to Joseph Barton
 together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances belonging to the same or in any wise incident or apper-

 administrators and assigns warrant and for ever defend the above men-
 tioned premises unto the said Shapleigh W Barton his heirs and execu-
 tors administrators and assigns against my self my heirs and assigns for and
 against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same

 the Sixth day of August Eighteen hundred and Twenty one having the following
 courses & courses beginning on a lower wood on Brushy Creek 37 running N 36 E to
 a post oak 34 thence N 60 E 22 10 to a Birch on Enore river thence down the
 meanders of said river to when it intersects with Brushy Creek thence up the
 various meanderings of said Creek to near the Spring thence bearing the
 meanders of the creek so as to include the Spring and one acre of Ground
 on the South side of said Creek thence back to the meanders of the Creek
 to the beginning corner bounded by Lands of William Smith Phillip C Lester
 Water W Smith and others containing Eighty four acres. Together with
