E to a chestnut thence N. 48 W. 26.50 to a chestnut thence S. 76 W. 27 to a Poplar thence S. 66 W. until it strikes the widow Coahans line thence with her lands until it strikes Robert Pittmans land and thence with said Pittmans land to the beginning corner it being a tract of land granted to Joseph Barton Senior also a parcel or tract of land bought of Robert Pittman Senior containing twenty acres more or less beginning on a Locust thence N. 55 E. 41 chains to a Locust thence S. 38 E. 9 chains to a Hickory thence a conditional line to a white oak thence to a chestnut oak thence to beginning corner. also including a tract or parcel of land bought by the said Dennis Pittman of W.
