

presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James McKinney all that tract piece or parcel of land situated in this State & District aforesaid near the head of a small branch waters of South Syper River said Land being part of a tract of six Acres of Land Ceded to Church by the Legislature of South Carolina in 1837. and runs as follows (viz) Beginning on a large Red Oak 3+ thence S 1/4 W 6.70 chains, to a Stake 3+ thence N 47 E 5.50 chains to a Stake 3+ thence S 43 E 3.28 to the beginning Red Oak 3+ containing nine Tenths of an Acre more or less, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James McKinney his heirs and assigns forever. And we the deacons above named do hereby bind our selves and our Successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said James McKinney his heirs & assigns against our selves as deacons & our Successors in office and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. To all to whom these presents shall come Know ye that I John F Gottshaw of the District and State aforesaid party of the first part for securing the payment of the Money herein after mentioned, and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to me duly paid by George W Gilbreath of the District and State aforesaid of the second part at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part. Two Stills Subs Stake stand and all the fixtures belonging to said stilling establishment also two cows and calves and a lot of twenty hogs a lot of corn supposed to be two hundred Bushells also one one horse waggon and now in the possession of John F Gottshaw to have and to hold all and singular the goods and chattes above bargained and sold or intended to be unto the said party of the second part his Executors administrators and assigns for ever. And I the said party of the first part for myself, my heirs executors and administrators all and singular the said goods and chattes above bargained and sold unto the said party of the second part his heirs executors administrators and assigns against me the said party of the first part and against all and every person or persons whomsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend upon condition that if the said party of the first part shall and do well and truly pay unto the said party of the second part his heirs executors administrators or assigns the full sum of sixty five Dollars and fifty four cents. On or before the 1st day of March next to satisfy two certain promissory Notes bearing date from the 6th day of May 1857 made by me in favor of the said George W Gilbreath then these presents shall be void. And I the said party of the first part for myself my executors administrators and assigns do covenant and agree, to and with the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns that in case default shall be made in the payment of said sum above mentioned then it shall and may be lawful for and I the said party of the first part do hereby authorize and empower the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns with the aid and assistance of any person or persons to enter my dwelling house still house corn crib Barn or other premises and such other place or places as the said goods or chattes or may be placed and take and carry away the said goods and chattes and to sell and dispose of the same for the best price they can obtain, and out of the money arising therefrom to retain and pay the said sum above mentioned and all charges touching the same, rendering the overplus if any unto me or to my executors administrators or assigns, and until default be made in the payment of the said sum of money I am to remain and continue in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said goods and chattes and the full and free enjoyment of the same without let hindrance or delay let my hand & seal this the 16th day of January in the year of our Lord One
