Beginning at a stake 34 on a line of E S Irvins lot and runs thence S 83 1/2
W 180 feet to a stake 34 thence N 55 W 244 feet to a stake 34 thence N 18
E 105 feet to a stake 34 lower corner of said Irvins lot thence with Irvins
line S 72 E 283 1/2 feet to the beginning corner containing a fraction over
three quarters of an acre more or less. Together with all & singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any way incident or appertaining. To have & to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Adams

and eight hundred and fifty eight between Samuel A Townes Esquire
commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Green
ville Court House in the said State of the one part & Isaac
Devenport of the Other part. Whereas Mary J Arnold on or
about the 26th day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand
and eight hundred and fifty eight exhibited her Bill of com
plaint in the Court of Equity, at Greenville Court House
in the said State, against John Arnold, Josephine Arnold et
al. And the cause heard at issue before the Honorable Court
came on to be heard at July term, in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight, when the said Court
after full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the pre
mises, did order Adjudge and decree, that the lands mention
ed and decreed in said Bill should be sold at Public Auction
by the Commissioner of the said Court, on the terms and for the
purposes mentioned in their Secretal Order, as by reference there
to in the Registry of the said Court, will appear and the said
Samuel A Townes, as Commissioner of the said Court after having
duly advertised the said Lands for sale, by public outcry on the

granted, Bargained, sold and Released, and by these presents
doth grant, Bargain, sell, and release, unto the said Isaac
Devenport Heirs, and assigns all that tract and parcel of

Greenville, and State aforesaid, known and described as follows
