 B C Prince et al Conyane To Wit, Whereas by the Last will and testament of my late husband Henry B Prince deceased I have a life interest in certain Personal Property therein named, and Whereas I am desirous of having the said property sold & divided out amongst my children according to the provisions of the will at once & in my life time, and Whereas the said children and legatees under the said will have agreed to provide a comfortable support for me during my life & to let me have the use of a negro girl named Mary to wait on me during my life time & some other property such a a bed & furniture, and one hundred dollars annually Now know all men by these presents that I Peggy Prince widow of the late Henry B Prince in consideration of a comfortable support guaranteed to me by my children & further in consideration of the use of a negro girl named Mary, and five dollars to me in hand paid the receipt of which I do hereby acknowledge, I have released and relinquished, bargained & sold transferred made over & by these presents do release & relinquish bargain & sell transfer & make over unto Baylis C Prince William F Prince Jasper J Prince Albertus M Prince, Sonora A Goodlett & Sophronia C Cunningham and their heirs forever all my interest in the personal property left me in the will of my deceased husband Henry B Prince whatsoever the same may be to have & to hold the same to them & their heirs to sell & dispose of the said property immediately & divide the proceeds of the same amongst them equally according to the terms & provisions of the said will as directed to be done at my death and I do warrant & forever defend all & singular the said interest to the said parties & their heirs against me & my heirs Executors & administrators & all others claiming or attempting to claim the same.
