 and released and delivered and by these presents grant bargain
 sell and deliver unto the aforesaid Jackson Nash of Greenville Dist-
 ict and State aforesaid all that tract or parcel of Land containing
 five and a half acres be the same more or less lying in Greenville
 District and State aforesaid lying on the waters of South Rabun
 Creek bounded by lands of Jackson Nash on the South side of South
 Rabun Creeke Likewise Edward Nash and Jackson Nash commencing
 South S 40 E 1 chain thence S 40 W 2 chains thence S 79 E 350 to 400
 + thence East 3 chains to Hickory + thence N 13 E 8.64 to rock + on
 thence N 70 W 3.91 to rock + at Mill Pond thence with the bend of
 Mill pond to + on the dam thence to the beginning corner. Together
 with all and singular the rights members appurtenances. To have and
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said Jackson Nash his heirs and assigns for ever and I the said
 Edward Nash do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators
 against myself my heirs lawfully claiming the same as witness

 of two hundred & fifty five dollars 50⁰⁰ to me in hand paid by Jack-
 son Brown of the same place I the said W B Jones have granted bargained
 sold & released and by these presents do grant sell and release unto Jackson
 Brown two pieces of land containing 36 1/2 acres more or less beginning
 at a hickory 3+ on the Georgia Road & runs thence S 20 W 9.33 to a stake 3+
 and N 63 W 14 1/2 to a hickory 3+ & N 29 E 9 to a stake 3+ S 61 1/4 E 18 1/4 to the road & along
 said road N 38 1/2 E 19.20 to a stake 3+ thence N 62 W 19 1/2 to a hickory 3+ & N 46
 E 13.36 to a hickory 3+ S 60 E 18 to a hickory 3+ & S 41 1/2 W 12.10 to the stake in said
 Road. Together with all and singular the above described pieces of land

containing 36 1/2 acres more or less with all the profits thereunto belong-

 & do by these presents grant bargain sell & release unto J Brown a certain
 plantation or tract of land containing 85 acres more or less beginning at
 a stake 3+ in the Georgia Road & runs thence along the road S 38 1/2 W 19.20 to
 a hickory 3+ thence N 61 1/2 W 18 1/4 to a stake 3+ & N 29 E 15.30 to a Post Oak 3+ small &
 N 77 W 18 1/4 to a Chestnut Stump 3+ N 17 W 19 to a hickory 3+ & S 75 E 40 to a
 lowerwood 3+ on a branch & up the meanders to a hickory 3+ & S 46 W 13.36 to a
 lowerwood 3+ & S 62 E 19 1/4 to the beginning corner in the road. Together with
 all and singular the above described premises hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereunto belonging and I the said Solomon K White do hereby bind myself
 my heirs executors administrators & assigns to warrant and forever defend
 the said plantation of 85 acres more or less unto Jackson Brown his heirs
 Executors Administrators and assigns to have and to hold in peaceable
 possession forever with all the profits thereunto belonging or in anywise
 incident to the said plantation against myself my heirs or assigns or any other
 person or persons lawfully to claim the same or any part thereof In
