S. Green on which now lives & lands of Thomas McCarroll & Martin Hunt in Beginning at a stake once a white oak near a branch and running thence N 54 W 27 1/2 to a stake thence N 24 1/2 W 9 8/16 to a person on in the fork of two branches one of them

called Armstrongs branch thence down the said Armstrong branch to a dead white oak thence S 73 E 13 1/4 to a red oak thence S 76 E 8 to a white oak near a branch & thence up the said last mentioned branch to the beginning stake corner together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
