 I Rebecca L Kabe of Green  
 County in the State of Tennessee for and in consideration  
 of the sum of Two Thousand dollars to me paid by Henry  
 Morris of Charleston in the State aforesaid have granted bargain  
 sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain  
 sell and release unto the said Henry Morris all that piece parcel  
 and lot of Land lying situate and being in the corporate limits  
 of the Town of Greenville and State aforesaid being the same  
 lot conveyed to me by Samuel A Cowles Commissioner of  
 Equity for Greenville District and sold by & under a decree of  
 said Court as the property of Isaac Mc Benedict deceased  
 which said lot was conveyed to I Mc Benedict by V Mc Bee  
 the said Lot having the following courses and distances  
 Beginning at a Stake 3+ on a street running from Doct Austins  
 Lot towards the west corner of a Lot belonging to Mrs Julia  
 D Roberts and runs thence with Mrs Roberts line S 23 W 200  
 feet to a Stake 3+ thence N 67 W 177 1/2 feet to a Stake 3+ thence  
 N 23 E 200 feet to a Stake 3+ on the street thence S 67 E 177 1/2  
 feet to the beginning corner containing three Woods and ten  
 perches more or less. Together with all and singular the  
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. So  
 have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
 unto the said Henry Morris his heirs and assigns forever and  
 I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators  
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises  
 unto the said Henry Morris his heirs and assigns against

 hand paid by the said Henry Morris which said Slave Susan I warrant  
 to be sound in body and mind and guarantee to the said Henry Morris  
 his heirs and assigns a good and valid title to the said Slave for life  
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this sixth day  
 of June 1859 Together with the hand & seal of my present wife Sally McKee
