I Olias Dill of Spartanburg District in the State aforesaid in consideration of two thousand and forty Dollars to me paid by Ananias Dill of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Ananias Dill all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville District on both sides of Mill Creek waters of South Fork of River Beginning on a Dead Red Oak corner and running thence S 24 W 24.90 to a stake thence S 89 1/2 W 11 chains to a Post oak old corner thence N 89 1/2 W 9.75 to a Sweet Gum old corner thence N 22 W 13.95 to a Red oak old and new corner thence N 16 1/2 W 26.35 to a Red oak new corner thence S 42 3/4 E 18.95 to a Post oak old corner thence N 64 3/4 E 26 chains to a Persimmon on bank of Creek thence S 28 E 15 chains to the beginning corner containing Eighty eight acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ananias Dill his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Ananias Dill his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

 Lemuel J. Hudson Land that I Thomas O Lownds of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Seven Hundred dollars to me paid by Lemuel J. Hudson of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Lemuel J. Hudson all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the District of Greenville & State aforesaid on the waters of Rock Creek of Enore River & Laurel Creek of Kedy River containing about two hundred acres more or less as the same may measure out being all the land I purchased of Pike on the north East side of the old Congaree Road beginning on the said Road & running North East across a branch of Rock Creek to a chestnut oak corner thence S 48 E 44.75 chs to a chestnut corner thence N 72 E 20.80 to a Pine corner thence S 33 E 8.75 chs to a stake corner thence South West in straight line to the old Congaree Road thence along said Road to the beginning corner on said Road in a North West direction as will more fully appear by the Plat of the said land attached to the deed of John Pike to me which includes the lands on the other side of the Congaree Road not sold by me Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lemuel J. Hudson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Lemuel J.
