This indenture made the Eleventh day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty between Robert Peden of the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the first part and Thomas Alexander Peden of Laurens District and the same State aforesaid of the second part. Witnesseth whereas the said Robert Peden is desirous to make provision for his daughter Mary Mc Boyd now of the age of thirty six years against future contingencies and for her maintenance and support and whereas the said Robert Peden is desirous that his said daughter should enjoy the labor and increase or the share or increase of the slaves hereinafter named and described during the term of her natural life free from the control liabilities or interference of any husband that she now has, or may hereafter have. Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Robert Peden in consideration of the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part and also in consideration of the love and affection I bear to my said daughter Mary Mc Boyd hath bargained sold and given and by these presents do give sell and give unto the said party of the second part. Two negro slaves (viz) Hannah aged sixteen & Prudence aged eleven years and valued at sixteen hundred dollars and one hundred dollars in money together with their future increase and also all the right title and claim I may have to said slaves either at Law or in Equity. To have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned and described slaves with their increase unto the said Thomas Alexander Peden his successors and assigns in trust however for the use and benefit of my said daughter during her natural life and at her death the said trustee or his successor is hereby directed to sell the said slaves. Together with their future increase and divide the proceeds equally among the heirs of her body paying after twelve months or after the money comes due to each distributee who shall have arrived to the age of twenty one years his or her distribution part the balance to be kept at interest and each distributee to receive his or her part as he or she arrives at the age of twenty one years. If any of her children should die before receiving his or her part then the portion coming to such deceased child or children to be equally divided among the surviving children provided such child or children left no issue but if issue be left then the said issue to receive what would have been coming to the Parent the trust to cease when the youngest child of my daughter Mary Mc Boyd shall have arrived at the age of twenty one years. This indenture made the Eleventh day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty between Robert Peden of Greenville District and the State of South Carolina of the first part and James S Peden of the same place of the second part. Whereas the said Robert Peden is desirous to make provision for his grand children Thomas C Peden Robt M Peden David Mc Peden and Mary C Peden the four children of my son John S Peden. Now this indenture witnesseth that I the said Robert Peden in consideration of the love and affection I had for my son John S Peden and which I bear to his children hath given and by these presents do give unto the said party of the second part ~~thirteen~~ sixteen hundred dollars in cash in trust however for the use and benefit of my said grand children above named, and the said trustee or his successor is hereby directed to pay Thomas C Peden who is now of age one fourth part of the said sum and to put the balance at interest and as each child comes of age to pay to him or her his or her distribution share of said sum if any of said children should die without issue then his or her part to be equally divided among the surviving children but if the child or children so dying leave any issue then and in that case the said child or children to be paid the amount that would have been coming to said Parent if alive this trust to cease when the youngest child above named arrives at the age of twenty one years.
