 of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifty eight  
 at the suit of C. C. Montgomery to me directed commanding  
 me that of the goods and Chattels lands and Tenements  
 of William Evans to levy the sum of One hundred and  
 seventy dollar damage and cost I have seized and taken  
 of the lands and tenements of the said William Evans  
 all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land containing  
 fifty acre more or less. acres situate and being in the  
 District of Greenville on the waters of Middle Saluda
