To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said Jesse Covell or his heirs and assigns forever, together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining and I bind my self my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the said premises unto the said Jesse Covell his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and against every other person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof My witness when I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 25th day of April A.D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty six.
