Markley by Note of hand under seal for the sum of Two thousand and hundred and forty Dollars and eighty eight cents with interest from the twentieth day of July 1860 the same being given for the purchase money of the tract of Land hereinafter mortgaged and described. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said John C. C. Turner for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of five dollars to the said John C. C. Turner by the said Thomas C. Gower Thomas Mc Coy and Henry C. Markley in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas C. Gower Thomas Mc Coy and Henry C. Markley, All that piece parcel and lot of Land containing three Woods and seventeen Perches, more or less, situated lying and being in Greenville District and State aforesaid within the corporate limits of the town of Greenville and bounded as follows Viz Beginning at a stake on the side of Pendleton Street and run S 20 1/2 E 40.6 feet to a stake on the side of a street, thence with said street N 26 1/2 E 152 feet to a stake on the side of the street thence with said street N 20 1/4 W 304 feet to a stake on Pendleton Street thence with said street S 65 1/4 W 102 feet to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
