

Begining at a P.O. on the Edge of Rutherford Road thence N 45° E 4° 78' to a State in laid Road thence N 67° W 23' 45" to S 0 34' 54" new thence N 52° W 36' 43" R. 0 34' 54" new thence S 20' 45" W 6' 50" to a State thence S 9° E 28' 15" to chestnut 34' 0m thence S 8° E 19' 00" R. 0 34' 54" 0m thence N 36' 43" E 17' 30" to S 9m 34' 37' 0m thence N 150' across the River to perpendicular 30m thence E 63' 08" to the beginning Except about thirteen acres of laid tract on the west side of Orange River which I reserve and which is not meant to be conveyed in this indenture Together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances herunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and revercions ~~back~~ and remains and remainders rents issues and profits thereof To have and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said John Williams his heirs and assigns forever provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of these parties that if the said George Green his heirs executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Williams the sum of \$1000 hundred dollars according to the three sealed Notes above mentioned, then and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and void, anything herein contained to the contrary being in anywise notwithstanding, and it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that until default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth, and the interest for the same it shall and may be lawful to and for the said George Green peaceably and quietly to hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and released, and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have receive and take the rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoof anything herein contained to the contrary being in anywise notwithstanding.

late of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of an Annuity of three hundred Dollars to be paid to me from year to year on the First day of January for and during the length and term of my natural life and in consideration that the said Jourdan P Pool doth and shall maintain and keep with wholesome food boarding and clothing my son John Wells for and during the term of my natural life and also in consideration of the affection which I have to him and my peace his wife and also in consideration of the many and great services which he has rendered to me in my lonely distressed and otherwise friendless age and also in consideration of the sum of One dollar to me in hand paid have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell transfer assign and deliver unto the said Jourdan P Pool all my right title interest and estate of every kind and character whatsoever either at Law or in Equity in and to the Estate both real and Personal of my late husband Elchanon Wells under the will of my said husband or by common Law or by Statute Law and also all my right title and interest of whatsoever kind or character to and in the Estate both Real and personal of my deceased son Carter Wells late of the District and State aforesaid as one of the he is at Law of my said son or otherwise to have enjoy and hold the same to him and his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby give and grant unto the said Jourdan P Pool full power and authority to demand and receive all sums of money which may now be due me or which may hereafter become due me from any person or persons whomsoever because and in right of any and all of the said interest title and estate herein before sold and assigned and when received to keep for the same or for any part thereof In witness whereof I have herein set my hand and affixed my seal this Eight day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty her
