 City of Greenville State aforesaid to wit being the vacant lot
 between my house and the house owned and occupied by
 Obediah A Pickle having the following boundaries South
 Pendleton Street with front on said Street commencing at
 an or on stake on line with said Pickles fence and running
 to a crop fence near my house measuring 96 feet 3 inches
 between said lines. North by Rhett Street with said amt of
 front. East by the lot on which my house stands. West by
 lot owned by said Obediah A Pickle with a depth of 291
 feet though from Pendleton to Rhett Street being a portion
 of lot decided to me by William Moore bearing date Feb'y 5-
