This Indenture made the fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine between William A McDaniel Esquire Clerk of the Honorable Circuit Court for Greenville County at Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part and William E Earle of the other part Whereas W A McDaniel Esquire Clerk Court Common Pleas & on or about the sixth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine exhibited his bill of complaint in the Circuit Court at Greenville Court House in the said State against Olisha N Coleman and David Coleman and the cause being at issue before the honorable Court came on to be heard at May Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine when the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order adjudge and decree that the Defendants Equity of Redemption in the Mortgage Premises as described in the Bill should be foreclosed & the said Land should be sold at public auction by the Clerk of the said Court on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear and the said William A McDaniel Esquire as Clerk of the said Court after having duly advertised the said Tract of Land for sale by Public outcry on the first Monday of fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of the said Tract of Land below described unto the said William E Earle for Four Hundred and Ten Dollars he being at that price the highest bidder for the same Now Therefore this indenture witnesseth that the said William A McDaniel Esquire as Clerk of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars paid him by the said W E Earle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said William E Earle his heirs and assigns all that Tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina adjoining lands of the said Olisha Coleman & others containing One Hundred and thirty seven Acre more or less being the same Tract of Land purchased by Olisha N Coleman from W M Thomas Esq. Commissioner in Equity on the 14 day of May 1866 as a part of the Real Estate of Joseph M. Dupuis deceased together with all and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the same with and without interest and profit thereof and also all the other rights titles and
