David and Samuel Stradley trading under the name and firm of David & Stradley of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said Joseph A. David and Samuel Stradley as aforesaid have by these presents agreed to make advancements to the said Alfred Heile for Agricultural purposes, not to exceed thirty five Dollars during the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy. Now the said Alfred Heile hereby agrees to give the said Joseph A.
