 Know all men by these presents  
 That James B Mays of Greenville  
 County in the State aforesaid for and  
 in consideration of the natural love and affection which  
 I bear for my brother Samuel E Mays of the aforesaid  
 State and County, and in further consideration of the sum  
 of Five Dollars to me paid by Hamlin Beattie of said  
 State and County have granted bargained sold and released  
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
 unto the said Hamlin Beattie the following three several pieces  
 parcels and tracts of land to wit Tract Number one  
 situate lying and being in Greenville County South Carolina  
 containing four hundred and fifty eight and one half acres  
 more or less, and having the following lines, metes and bounds  
 viz Beginning at a cedar tree S 48 E 26.00 on the North Bank of  
 the South Fork of Saluda River, running thence N 57 1/2 W 26.00  
 to a Cherry Tree S 48 E 115.50 to Hickory S 40 W  
 thence N 46 E 25.00 thence S 55 1/4 E 7.50 to a Sourwood S 45 E 10 m  
 thence S 16 1/2 W 72.00 to a Rock S 41 N m thence S 18 1/2 E 6.68 to a rock S 41 N m  
 on Greenville Road thence S 63 W 16.66 to a Branch, thence S 34 1/2  
 E 14.70 to a corner near my residence, thence S 44 1/4 W 17.50 to a stake  
 S 4 N m thence S 50 1/4 W 7.31 thence S 22 1/4 W 10.79 thence S 41 1/2 E 8.22  
 thence S 75.84 W 6.10 thence to a Rock S 45 N m on the  
 North Bank of the South Fork of Saluda River, thence up the  
 meanders of said River to the Beginning corner, Tract Number  
 Two situate lying and being in the County of Pickens and State of  
 South Carolina containing one hundred acres more or less and having the  
 following lines, metes and bounds viz Beginning at a pine stump near  
 old Road and running thence due West 51 chains to a Red oak S 40 m in
