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A Mortgage Deal The State of South Carolina
W.C. Humphrey Estate This Indenture made the third day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy between William C. Humphrey of the one part and Absolam Blythe and William C. Earle of the other part Witnesseth Whereas the said Absolam Blythe and William Earle are indebted to the said William C. Humphrey in the sum of twenty seven hundred dollars by two single bills whereof the following are copies
1st Sixty days from the first of October next we or either of us promise to pay William C. Humphrey or assign one thousand three hundred and fifty dollars for value received as witness our hands and seals this 3rd of September 1870
2nd Ninety days from the first of October next we or either of us promise to pay William C. Humphrey or assign one thousand and three hundred and fifty dollars for value received as witness our hands and seals this third day of December September 1870
Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Absolam Blythe for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of five dollars to the said Absolam Blythe by the said William C. Humphrey in hand paid set and before the sealing and delivery of this presents have granted bargained sold and released and by this presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William C. Humphrey all

that tract of land lying on both sides of Santa Saluda River in the Counties of Greenville and Pickens adjoining lands of Mrs. M. A. Carson J. B. Cleveland and others containing two thousand acres more or less and more particularly described in the last will and testament of Absolam Blythe is deceased to which reference is hereby had & being the same tract of land devised to the said Absolam Blythe by the said Absolam Blythe is deceased and particularly described in said last will and testament together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said William C. Humphrey his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators to warrant defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William C. Humphrey his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomever lawfully claiming or claim the same or any part thereof Provided always nevertheless that it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said Absolam Blythe and William C. Earle their heirs executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said William C. Humphrey the sum of two thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars according to the terms of the two single bills above mentioned then and from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and void anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding. And it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents that until payment shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth and the interest for the same it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Absolam Blythe his heirs and to have receive and take the rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoof anything herein contained to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding
