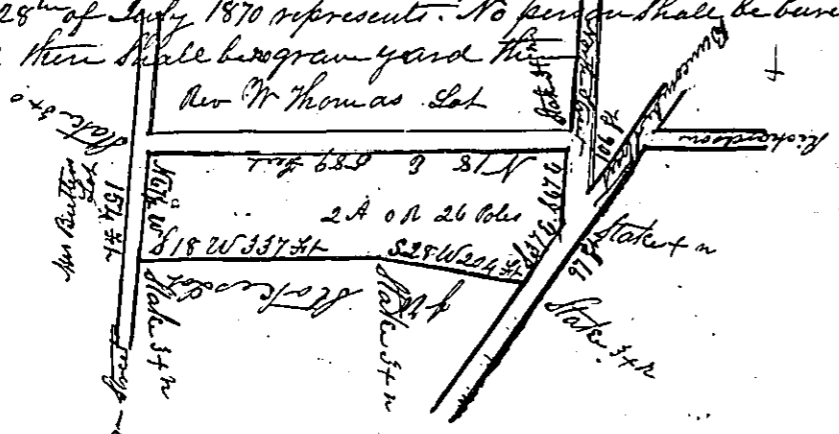


Separate lying and being in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, beginning at a Stake 3+ at the corner of North and Richardson Street and running thence along Richardson Street N 18 E 58.7 feet to a Stake 3+ thence along the street running in front of the Baptist Female College N 67 1/2 W 154 feet to a Stake 3+ thence along John W Stokes Lot S 18 W 33.7 to a Stake 3+ thence along the said Lot of John W Stokes S 28 W 20.4 feet to a Stake 3+ on the Buncombe Street thence along the Buncombe Street S 37 E 97 feet to a Stake 3+ thence along North Street S 67 E 106 feet to the beginning corner containing Two Acs and Seventy Six Rods, more or less being the lot which of the service conveyed to the said J Henry Stokes and hath such shape marks and boundaries as the plat hereto attached bearing date the 25th of July 1870 represents. No person shall be buried on said Lot and there shall be no grave yard there.



Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said J. A. Davis, M. H. Gains, J. D. Carpenter, W. H. Lester, W. Holland, J. C. Alexander, & C. C. Hyde, or stewards of said Methodist Episcopal Church South and to their successors in office and assigns forever in fee simple. And I do hereby bind my self & my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said stewards and their successors in office and their assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

M. R. Beeco	Land	Thomas H. Cole and Emily H. Cole of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration

of Eighty Seven ⁵⁰ Dollars to us paid by Miles R. Beeco of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Miles R. Beeco a certain tract piece or parcel of land situate in the County and State aforesaid 3 Miles East from Greenville on the Road to P. O. Lownds One Lot containing One Acre One Rod Seventeen poles more or less and hath such bounds marks as follows viz. beginning at a Pine 3+ thence N 1/4 E 3.70 to a Stake 3+ thence N 48 W 3.70 to a Stake 3+ thence S 42 W 2.78 to a Stake 3+ thence S 48 E 6.20 to the beginning corner also a half interest in another Lot fronting the road above named containing Two Acs more or less and hath such bounds marks &c. as follows viz. Beginning one R. O. 3+ down on said road thence S 48 E 8.00 to a Stake 3+ thence N 42 E 2.50 to a Stake 3+ thence N 48 W 8.00 to a Stake 3+ near a R. O. thence S 42 W 2.50 to the beginning. Being the same Lot decided by H. E. Martin to J. W. Wood for Mary Richards and Emily Richards bearing date the 25th February 1854 and the same on which H. E. Richards now lives. Provided that the within named Miles R. Beeco permits the said H. E. Richards and his wife Mary Richards to reside on the said Lot during life according to a former understanding between the parties within mentioned M. R. Beeco and wife Mary Beeco & H. E. Cole and wife Emily H. Cole. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the land premises
