Greer all that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the City and County of Greenville and State of South Carolina containing one one half acre more or less and having the following Metes and bounds to wit Two hundred and eighty two feet on the South one hundred and twenty feet on Spring Street on the East Two hundred feet on Water lot on the North and one hundred and twenty feet on Brown Street on the West lying the premises formerly known as the Prince & Greer Living Stables Together with all and singular the rights wheresoever Hereditaments appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way incident or appertaining I do here and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John N. Greer his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend against all and singular the said premises unto the said John N.
