Moore Co. C. C. in a deed dated Octo 7: 1867 and recorded in the office of the Register of Messine Camyane Dist. C. C. page 67 which is hereby referred to as a part of his deed Together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to them and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said City Council of the City of Greenville their Successors in Office and assigns from And I do hereby bind my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said City Council of the City of Greenville their Successors in Office and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
